

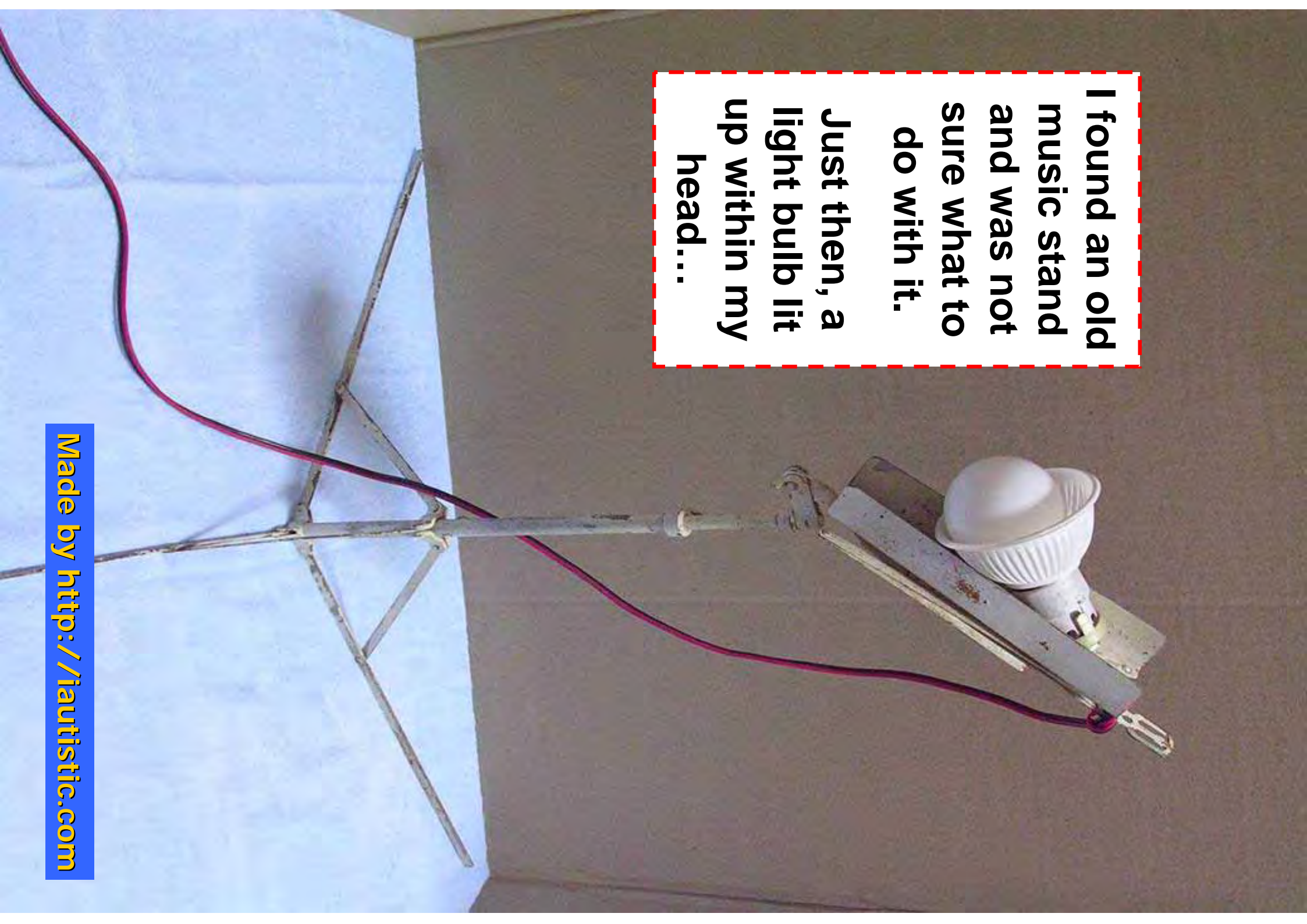

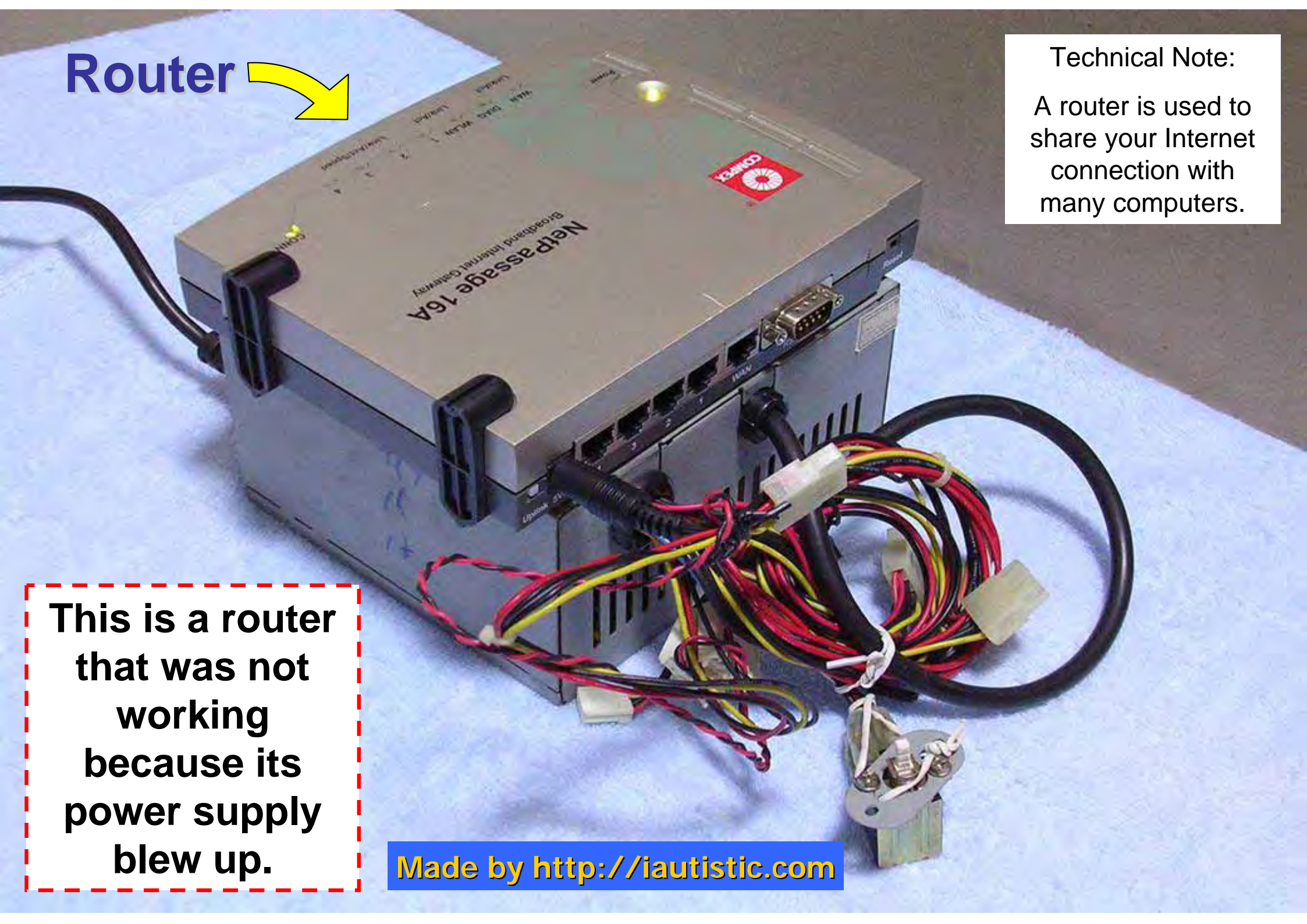

A PSU, or power supply unit, is usually found at the back of every desktop computer.

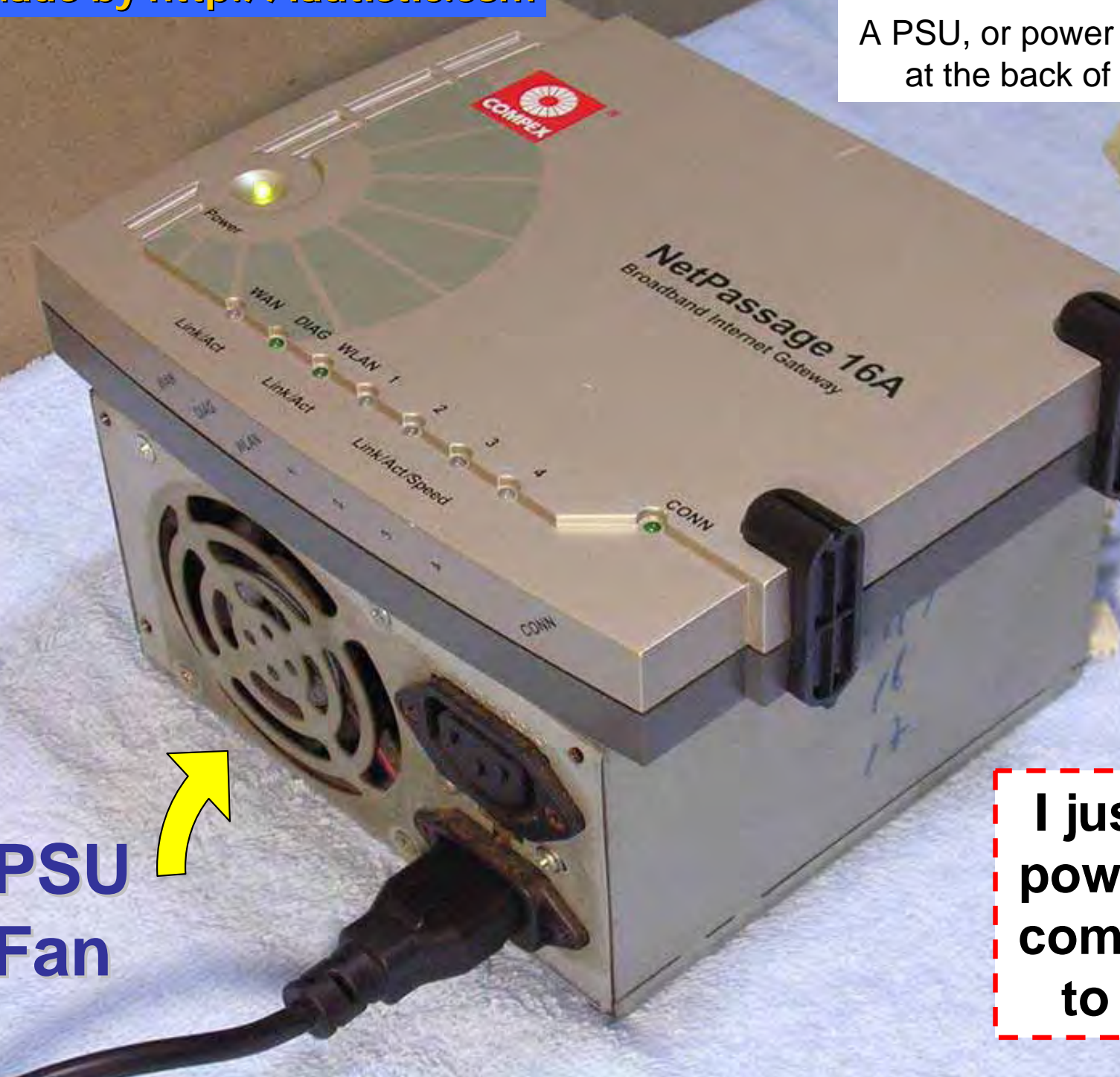

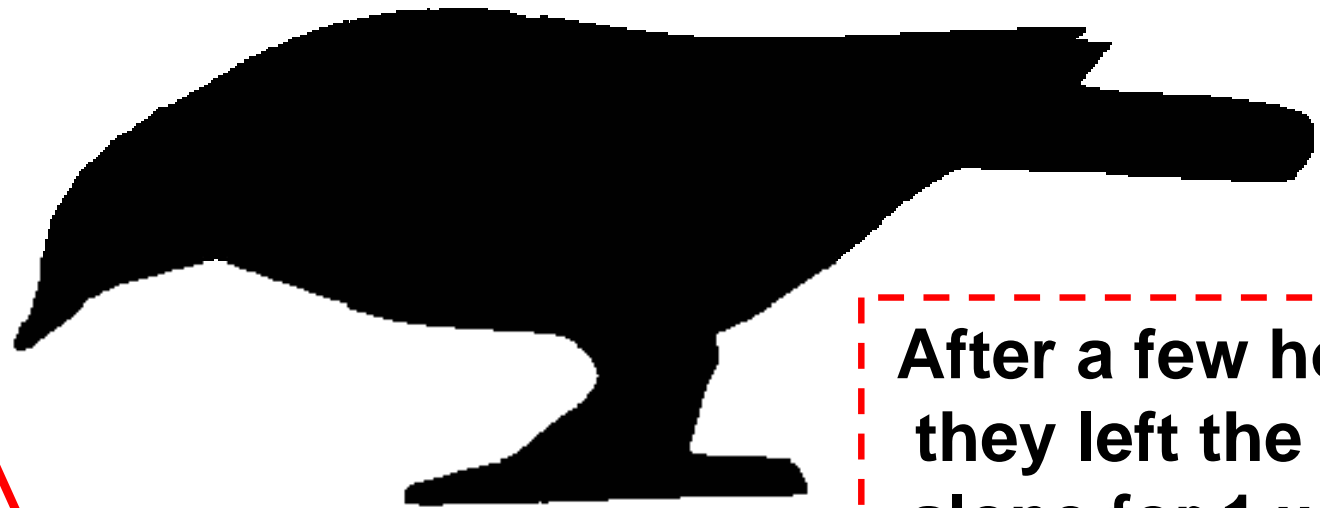

After a few hours, they left the stall alone for 1 week.

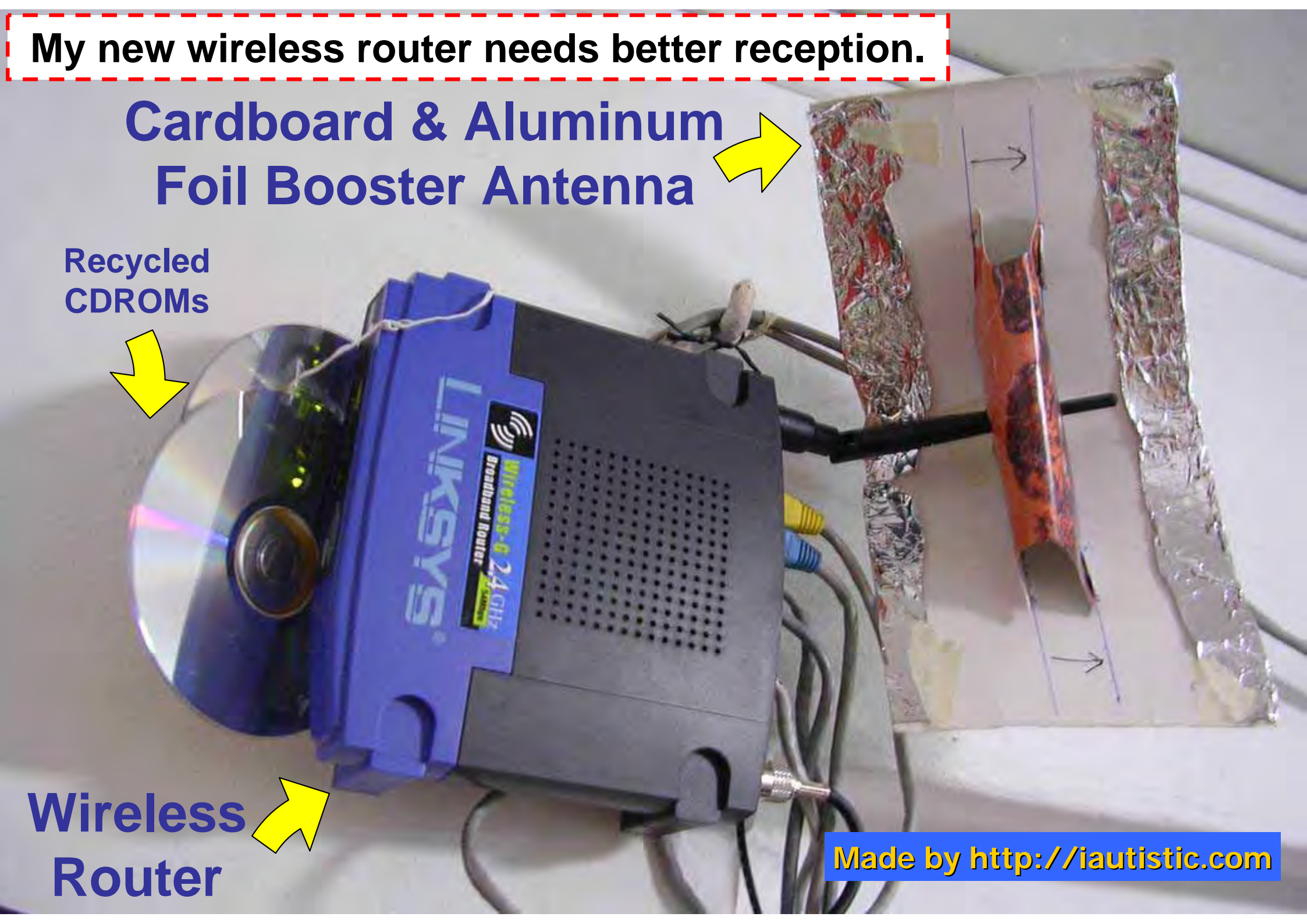
